Stone can be placed directly on the earth without requiring a concrete foundation. When the soil is ready, we create a base using sand, mortar, crushed stone, or cement. The perimeter of the pavers are cemented to prevent movement, while the rest of the area floats on compacted sand in a pattern of your choice.

Paver Installation Options for Every Budget and Style

It is important to establish your budget for the project in advance. Paver materials are available in a wide range of options and prices. Natural stone options range from travertine, marble, limestone and can be twice the price of concrete pavers. In addition to the cost of the materials, the size of the project, dump fees, and any property obstacles will affect the total cost.

When choosing your pavers, consider how the materials look with your overall design and use of space. Your paver installation should complement your environment, the landscaping, and exterior. Choose from warm or cool tones.

You should also consider the amount of space you have and the layout of the area where you want the install. Consider the natural traffic pattern, trash pads, stairs, sitting areas, access and entry points.

Proper Paver Maintenance for Best Results

Some pavers are more complicated to maintain than others. Pavers require annual cleaning with a coarse-bristle brush in addition to weed prevention. To prevent pavers from shifting, top off the space in between paving stones with jointing sand. Regularly sweep and hose your installation to keep them looking new. Upgrade to polymeric sand, which is a mixture of fine sands and polymers that form a strong binding agent.

Tree roots, weeds and grass can grow under and in between pavers. In some cases, can even cause shifting and damage. There are several products on the market that help prevent this from occurring.

Be cautious of creating tripping hazards with the pavers due to their overall thickness and sand base. It is important that any raised surfaces are flush with other surfaces to minimize risk. Installations on concrete for instance, raise the surface level. This may prevent gates or doors from opening and require concrete demolition to ensure accessibility.
